Stop using these immediately and return them to an authorized Dacor dealer (<http://www.divedacor.com/>) for a free repair. Cressi-Sub SCUBA Buoyancy Compensators are being recalled by Cressi-sub USA, of Westwood, NJ, USA (Distributor) / Cressi-sub S.p.A., of Genoa, Italy (Manufacturer) because the expansion of an internal cable housing can cause a slow leak from the shoulder exhaust. Return the product to a Cressi-sub-authorized dive shop (800-338-9143) to have it retro-fitted with a free replacement internal cable housing.
